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MESSAGE FROM THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

Dear Law Enforcement Colleague –

We are pleased to update you on the progress we have made in recent months to improve the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program for the State of Wisconsin. The Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement Services, through the Bureau of Justice Information and Analysis (BJIA), is making significant enhancements to the UCR program, which serves as the primary source for statewide crime and arrest statistics, as reported by local law enforcement. The BJIA recently launched a web-based application to allow Summary-Based Reporting (SBR) agencies to securely enter monthly crime and arrest statistics online. Since the full launch of this application in March 2015, almost all SBR agencies have registered and many have starting submitting data online. This was no small undertaking as the transition to online reporting impacted more than 280 agencies. We appreciate the cooperation and support we have received from agencies in helping to move this forward in a short period of time. Online reporting offers many benefits, including giving agencies increased control over their data submissions, while at the same time improving the quality of the data through validation checks which allow agencies to more readily identify and resolve errors. This transition will also allow the state UCR program to redirect resources onto improving the quality of the UCR data and making UCR reports and data more available for research and analysis. In addition to the changes to SBR, the BJIA also has been working on an update to the Wisconsin Incident-Based Reporting System (WIBRS) to enhance the process for submitting data, offer more timely feedback on data submissions, improve the tracking of data validation errors, and increase the availability of online tools to allow agencies to quickly access and analyze their data. Many of these changes are currently being rolled out to WIBRS agencies. WIBRS provides tracking of additional crime issues facing law enforcement today, including expanded offenses such as human trafficking, fraud, kidnapping and other sex offenses. WIBRS also includes more detailed information on offenses, victim and offender demographics, property, weapons and related crime characteristics than is available through SBR. The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and other federal partners are working to expand incident-based reporting at a national level. The BJIA recently applied for a planning grant under the National Crime Statistics Exchange (NCS-X) project to evaluate the impact this may have on the Wisconsin UCR program and local law enforcement agencies. If your agency is interested in transitioning to WIBRS, please contact the BJIA at statsanalysis@doj.state.wi.us.

Looking ahead, the BJIA is preparing for an upcoming UCR Quality Assurance Review by the FBI and will be working with the local agencies that have been selected for review as part of this process. In addition, the BJIA is continually seeking opportunities to enhance the UCR program by making data submission and feedback more timely, accurate, and beneficial, as well as providing training and resources to assist local agencies. The current focus is on developing additional data quality reports and analysis tools to assist both the BJIA and local law enforcement agencies in improving the quality of the

UCR data, as well as to make it more readily available for analysis. Thank you for your continued support of the UCR program as we undergo significant changes and enhancements. Your continued commitment to providing accurate and timely crime and arrest information is key to supporting data-driven decision making and policies, with a focus on reducing crime and victimization in the State of Wisconsin.

State v. Delebreau Decided by the Wisconsin Supreme Court (June 6, 2015)

Issue:

This case involved the reading of the Miranda warning to a subject, who has an attorney, but who has not invoked the Miranda right to counsel. Specifically, the Wisconsin Supreme Court dealt with whether it wished to adopt the Louisiana v Montejo rule. The Montejo rule is that the hiring of an attorney is not an invocation of the Miranda right to an attorney; the Miranda right is only invoked when a subject is read his/her rights and then says they want a lawyer. Ultimately, in this case, the Wisconsin Supreme Court adopted the Montejo rule.

Facts:

The defendant was taken into custody on a probation hold. The defendant sent a note to jail officials requesting an opportunity to speak with a narcotics investigator. A few days later, while still in continuous custody, the defendant was charged with the delivery of heroin, made his initial appearance in court, and was represented by an attorney with the Public Defender's office. The next day, still in custody, the defendant met with a police investigator.

The investigator read the defendant his Miranda rights and the defendant waived his rights and did not ask for counsel. In this interview the defendant admitted to selling illegal drugs. The investigator returned three days later to again interview the defendant. Again the rights were read and were waived and during this interview the defendant said that since he was going to end up in prison, he might as well just cooperate with law enforcement.

The two custodial interviews where the defendant made incriminating statements were used as evidence in the defendant's trial.

The Defendant's Argument:

The defendant argued that his statements should be suppressed since he had retained counsel

before either interview was conducted. So, since he had already been charged with a crime, and was represented by counsel, the police should be barred from approaching him and trying to initiate an interrogation.

The State's Argument:

The state argued that the fact that the defendant had retained counsel prior to the interviews was irrelevant; the key is that the defendant had not yet invoked his Miranda right to counsel as he had not yet been read his rights.

The Wisconsin Supreme Court Holding:

The high court agreed with the state. The court reasoned that the filing of a charge and the retention of the attorney are not invocations of the Miranda right to attorney. This invocation only occurs when a defendant is read the Miranda form and submits that he wants counsel, or while in custody clearly advises the police that he wants a lawyer during police questioning. Otherwise he is fair game for a police approach. In reaching this holding the high court definitively adopted the Montejo rule for Wisconsin.

Caution:

Once a person is in custody, and invokes his right to counsel by responding to the warning or preemptively telling the police that he wants a lawyer for questioning, he/she is "off limits" unless he/she reinitiates the police contact or is released from custody for 14 continuous days.

Wisconsin State Patrol Mobile Data Browser (MDB) System and Mobile Architecture for Communications Handling (MACH) Software Alternative

Users of the Mobile Data Browser (MDB) system supported by the Wisconsin State Patrol received notice on November 11, 2014 that the system is scheduled to be taken offline. The December 31st, 2015 deactivation date is due to an inability of the antiquated MDB system to meet new Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) security requirements.

As a replacement for the messaging and TIME system query capabilities of the MDB system, the Wisconsin State Patrol and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources have jointly funded the sub-licensing of a software called Mobile Architecture for Communications Handling (MACH). MACH is offered through the National Model. <http://www.nationalmodel.us/>

The MACH software uses a broadband connection, GPS and downloaded maps to provide users with automatic vehicle location (AVL) capabilities. Beyond AVL functionality, MACH provides users with enhanced messaging features and the ability to securely run advanced queries of the TIME system. TIME system returns from MACH can be imported into the forms within the Traffic and Criminal Software (TraCS) software used by agencies across the state.

The MACH sub-license agreement has allowed the Wisconsin State Patrol to make the software available to more than sixty additional government public safety agencies including those seeking an alternative to the MDB system. Additional user agency costs are limited to those associated with the broadband data expenses, a \$12 per year/per mobile unit Google Maps user fee and the expense of the hardware necessary to run MACH. The hardware requirements for MACH are identical to those required for Traffic and Criminal Software (TraCS) and the Incident Location Tool (ILT).

FBI REPORT ON OFFICERS KILLED

Law Enforcement Officers Killed in the Line of Duty Summary Report – 2015

These statistics represent preliminary information received by the FBI during 01/01/2015 through 09/01/2015:

26 law enforcement officers have been killed due to criminal actions. During same time period in 2014, 32 officers were slain. Circumstances involving the 26 officers slain in 2015 are as follows: 7 were performing traffic pursuits or stops; 4 were investigating suspicious persons or circumstances; 4 were killed as result of unprovoked attacks; 1 was answering disturbance call (2 being domestic-related); 2 officers were involved in tactical situations; 1 was answering robbery call or pursuing robbery suspect; 1 was answering burglary call or pursuing burglary suspect; 1 was involved in drug-related matter; 1 was ambushed; 1 was handling, transporting, custody of prisoner; and 1 was attempting other arrest.

14 of the 26 victim officers feloniously killed were employed by law enforcement agencies in the South, 7 in the West, 3 in the Midwest, and 2 in the Northeast.

23 of the 26 victim officers were killed by subjects using firearms (15 handguns, 3 rifles, 1 shotgun, and 4 firearm types not reported). Three victim officers were intentionally killed by subjects using motor vehicles as weapons. Ten victim officers were confirmed to be wearing body armor at time of incident, 1 was confirmed to not be wearing body armor and body armor usage has not been reported for 15 victim officers. There have been 25 separate incidents in which these 26 victim officers have been slain. Twenty-Four of the 26 incidents have been cleared by arrest or exceptional means.

30 law enforcement officers have been accidentally killed. During same time period in 2014, 24 officers were accidentally killed. Circumstances involving the 30 officers are as follows: 18 were involved in automobile accidents, 4 were fatally struck by vehicles, 3 were fatally injured in motorcycle accident, 2 were accidentally shot, 1 officer was fatally injured in ATV accident, 1 was fatally injured in aircraft accident, and 1 officer fell to his/her death. Twenty of the 30 victim officers accidentally killed were employed by law enforcement agencies in the South, 4 in the Midwest, 3 in the West, and 3 in the Northeast.

Incident Summaries

Shreveport Police Department (Shreveport PD), Louisiana

Advised Police Officer, aged 29, with 4 years law enforcement experience with agency, was fatally shot on 08/05/2015. At approximately 9:15pm., officer responded to suspicious person call. Subject was possible family member of caller, armed, and had outstanding arrest warrant for second degree attempted murder. Upon arrival, officer made contact with individual who stated subject was inside house. Officer knocked on door of residence and commanded someone to show their hands. Gunshots were immediately fired. Officer called for assistance on his police radio, stating shots were fired and he had been hit. Three additional shots were fired, disabling victim officers body microphone.

Responding Shreveport PD officers arrived and located victim officer inside residence motionless on floor. Scene of incident was secured and Shreveport Fire Department transported victim officer to medical facility where he was pronounced deceased. Victim officer was found to have six gunshot wounds, including wounds to his face and head. Fifteen expended shell casings were located at scene of incident, and victim officers service weapon with attached flashlight had been taken.

Manhunt efforts were organized and operated by officers and agents from surrounding city, county, state and federal law enforcement agencies. Warrant was issued for subject for first degree murder of police officer. Shortly after 3pm., on 08/06/2015, information was received from source that subject had associates at certain address. Law enforcement officers responded to address and subject was immediately apprehended in backyard.

Carson City Sheriffs Office, Nevada

Advised Veteran Deputy Sheriff, aged 35, with 9 years law enforcement experience with agency, was fatally shot on 08/15/2015. At approximately 2:18am., victim deputy and another deputy responded to complaint of domestic violence.

Upon arrival, deputies made contact with female who had visible injuries. As second deputy was conducting interview of injured female, victim deputy attempted to make contact with subject at front door of residence. Victim deputy was fired upon at doorstep by subject. Victim deputy returned fire and struck subject in midsection underneath heart. Both victim deputy and subject succumbed to their injuries at scene of incident. Subsequent review of social media identified several posts in which subject expressed displeasure with law enforcement.

Louisiana State Police, Lake Charles, Louisiana

Advised Veteran Senior Trooper, aged 44, with over 11 years law enforcement experience with agency, was shot on 08/23/2015. At approximately 2:45pm., trooper responded to reports of erratic driver. Upon arrival, vehicle was located in ditch next to highway with subject sitting in drivers seat. Without provocation, subject shot victim trooper in head with 12-gauge shotgun. Passerby responded, struggled with and disarmed subject, holding him until other law enforcement units were able to respond. Incident was captured on victim troopers dash camera. On 08/24/2015, victim trooper succumbed to his injuries. Subject has been charged with first degree murder.

It was later learned, subject may have also murdered his roommate prior to traffic stop. His roommates body was discovered after victim trooper was shot. This incident is currently being investigated by Calcasieu Parish Sheriffs Office and may have been motive for subject choosing to shoot victim trooper.

Sunset Police Department, Louisiana

Advised Veteran Corporal, aged 51, with 13 years law enforcement experience with agency, was fatally shot on 08/26/2015. In early afternoon, corporal responded to domestic disturbance call. Subject went to home and had argument with wife. Argument escalated into assault by subject on wife and her two sisters, stabbing them multiple times.

When corporal arrived at residence, struggle began and subject obtained corporals duty weapon. Subject shot corporal in stomach using victim corporals weapon and then fled scene. Subject crashed his vehicle into convenience store and began to randomly shoot at people in and around store. Subject then barricaded himself in convenience store office. St. Landry Parish Swat Team later extracted subject from office, arresting and charging him with first degree murder. Victim corporal and one female both succumbed to their injuries.

OVERVIEW: This course is intended for all law enforcement personnel who are involved in any aspect of a death investigation. Topics relate to all types of deaths that range from suicides, accidents, suspicious or unexpected deaths, and homicides. The course is intended to equip the death investigator with the skills and knowledge necessary to conduct a thorough death investigation. Topics included in the agenda consist of Managing & Processing a Death Scene, Violent Crime Scene Analysis, Interviewing & Documenting Statements, use of the Crime Lab (DNA Emphasis), Contributions of the Autopsy, Child & Infant Death Investigations, Equivocal Death Investigations, Investigative Tools, Formal Investigative Techniques, investigating Child Abductions & Homicides, Incident Command, and Legal Issues in death investigations. Attendees will be exposed to a variety of formal and informal investigative techniques used to identify and develop suspects in death investigations.
